All Victorian government schools must develop a 4-year Strategic Plan.

All schools must prepare a *School Strategic Plan* that sets out the school's:

- philosophy
- goals
- targets to improve student outcomes
- strategies for achieving them



This year our school will take part in the School Review process. At the completion of the Review, we will have our next Four-Year Strategic Plan.

Basic steps for our School Review:

1. **Pre-review Self-Evaluation** – The School engages its community in a Self-evaluation, in preparation for the review process. This is the stage we are currently in.
2. **Validation Day** – One Day. The Panel tests and validates school's Self Evaluation and agrees on school's performance against goals and targets. This informs the focus and duration of the review. The Panel develops focus questions and plans for the rest of the review. The Panel includes an independent *Reviewer*, two *Challenge Partners* from other schools and our *Senior Education Improvement Officer*, to ensure they are able to provide a non-biased view of our school.
3. **Fieldwork** – 2 Days. The *School Review Panel* members are involved in the fieldwork. They will talk to our children, parents, School Council members and staff. They will also observe the teaching and learning in our classrooms. After the fieldwork is complete, they come together to discuss their findings.
4. **Review Report** - The Reviewer then develops a report which reflects Panel's views. The Report includes key directions on goals, targets for the next Strategic Plan (4 Years).


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


